

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Sarathi Hospital, Nalbari

And

Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya, Nalbari

PREAMBLE

This memorandum of understanding is made between Sarathi Hospital, Nalbari, Assam-781335 and Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya, Vidyapur, Nalbari, Assam-781335

It was dream of an experienced team of doctors who has been serving the people of lower Assam under the leadership of Dr. Tapan Deka for last 49 years and more, to initiate a change towards the health sector of Nalbari and entire lower Assam. Though Guwahati has always been the central hub for all the industries including health of entire North-East India, yet the health sector of lower Assam was suffering from ages due to poor communication system and underdeveloped infrastructure. Other than one or two exceptions lower Assam never had a standard medical facility. Nalbari Maternity Hospital was one among those exceptions but it is a specialised hospital dedicated to Gynaecology and Neonatology. Sarathi Multi speciality Hospital or simply Sarathi Hospital is an initiative by Nalbari Maternity Hospital to deliver a full equipped multi specialty healthcare facility to the people. With years long service experiences of this team, have helped them to construct a hospital keeping in mind about the requirements that they felt lacking in all those years in lower Assam. In 2018 Sarathi Hospital started its operation and it already has started to prove itself as one of the best hospital in Assam. Sarathi Hospital is a unique example of a newly developed hospital owned by a management having experience for more than 49 years.

Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya is a premier institution of higher education for girls in Nalbari, one of the traditionally enlightened districts of Assam. It was established on 01-08-1979 solely with the liberal charity of a great philanthropist, Late Mahendra Narayan Choudhury. The college has taken all possible steps for promoting higher education especially among the girls' so as to mould them into responsible citizens of the country and better human beings. The college is affiliated to Gauhati University, Guwahati and duly recognized under 2 (f) and 12 (B) by University Grants Commission in 1996. In 2004 NAAC has accredited the college with B++ grade. In 2006 UGC has recognized the college as a College with Potential for Excellence (CPE). Again, in 2016 NAAC has accredited the college with 'A' grade. Presently, the college has a strength of approximately 2200 number of students enrolled in various programmes.

1. INTENT OF WORK

Through this document based on the principle of equality and mutual benefit, Sarathi Hospital and Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya hereby agree to undertake activities focussing on enrichment of knowledge and co-operate in establishing closer links involving:

- Joint Internship/Training.
- Joint Research activities.
- Organization of joint Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, Job Fair, Health Camp etc.
- Job opportunities to the students of M.N.C.B.M.
- Joint survey work.
- Special discount on medical expenses for teachers, non-teaching staff and students of M.N.C.B.M. at Sarathi Hospital.

It is intended that specific collaborative arrangements between the two institutions will be set out in separate agreements.

It is also proposed that Sarathi Hospital and Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya will work together to identify and secure new opportunities in support of the proposed collaborative activities.

2. FINANCIAL INVOLVEMENT:

Financial involvement in connection with any programme undertaken as per the MOU will be sorted out and arranged by the institutions after mutual discussion.

3. ARBITRATION:

3.1 Except in noting the provisions of this MOU, no use of the name, symbol, sign of one institution shall be made by the other.

3.2 This agreement shall become effective from the date of its signing and continue thereafter for five years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement.

3.3 Termination by one institution, with prior intimation to the other institution before at least three months, will automatically invalidate the MOU.

3.4 In case of any controversy regarding scope and any provision of this MOU, mutually agreed decision of the Chief Administrator, Sarathi Hospital and the Principal, Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya will be final.

3.5 This document is a statement of understanding and is not intended to create bindings or legal obligations on either party.



