MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This memorandum of understanding is made on Tuesday, 9th of May, 2023.

Between

On

Educational Activities, Employability, Skill Enhancement and Research

Co-operation

Suren Das College, Hajo, Kamrup, Assam, India, Pin 781102 hereinafter referred to as 'SDC' and Mahendra Narayan Choudhury Balika Mahavidyalaya, Vidyapur, Nalbari, Assam, India, Pin 781335 hereafter referred to as 'MNCBM' referred to as '**the Party**' and jointly referred to as '**the Parties**'

ACKNOWLEDGING that

1. SDC is a degree level provincialised educational institution, having its address as Dhoparguri, Hajo, Kamrup, Assam, India, PIN-781102.
2. 'MNCBM' is a degree level provincialised educational institution, having its address as Vidyapur, Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN- 781335.

DESIRING to support the co-operation between the Parties in educational, employability & skill enhancement and research co-operation activities;

PURSUANT to the prevailing laws and regulations, policies and procedures applicable in the state of Assam and India.

HAVE REACHED the following understanding:

ARTICLE 1

OBJECTIVE OF CO-OPERATION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to co-operate in educational, employability & skill enhancement and research co-operation activities in areas of mutual interest.

ARTICLE 2

SCOPE OF CO-OPERATION

The Parties agree to implement co-operation programmes including but not limited to:

- a. Faculty and student exchange.
 - b. Curriculum development of certificate and diploma courses.
 - c. Co-operation during conduct of student study tours/survey works
 - d. Undertaking joint research activities.
 - e. Co-operation in extension activities.
 - f. Organizing joint seminars, conferences and workshops
 - g. Exchange of educational materials, publications and academic information.
- Any other areas as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE 3

LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

1. The Parties agree to implement the activities stated in ARTICLE 2 at SDC and MNCBM.
2. Any change to the location of the activities shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE 4

EXECUTING AGENCIES

To implement the M.O.U:-

1. SDC appoints the Co-ordinator, IQAC, SDC (hereinafter referred as SDC Rep.)
2. MNCBM appoints the Co-ordinator, IQAC, MNCBM (hereinafter referred as MNCBM Rep.).

ARTICLE 5

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

1. Any co-operation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval by relevant authorities
2. Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and programme specific arrangements.

ARTICLE 6

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

1. Each party shall protect, within its capacity and territory, intellectual property rights of the other Party in accordance with the laws and regulations in force in the state of Assam and the country of India.
2. In case of specific arrangement, programmes, activities or projects that may result in intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangement in accordance with the prevalent laws and regulations in the state of Assam and the country of India.

ARTICLE 7

CONFIDENTIALITY

In the event that either Party wishes to disclose and data/or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MOU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent of the other Party.

ARTICLE 8

LIMITATIONS OF PERSONAL ACTIVITIES

The Parties shall ensure that their personnel engaged in the activities under this MOU shall engage only in activities under the framework of this MOU with respect to laws and regulations in the state of Assam and the Country of India.

ARTICLE 9

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the Parties.

ARTICLE 10

AMMENDMENT

1. This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
2. Such amendments or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

ARTICLE 11

ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
2. This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five (5) years by mutual consent of the Parties.
3. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, one (1) month prior to the date of the termination.
4. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any programmes, activities or projects in progress and not completed at the time of termination.


