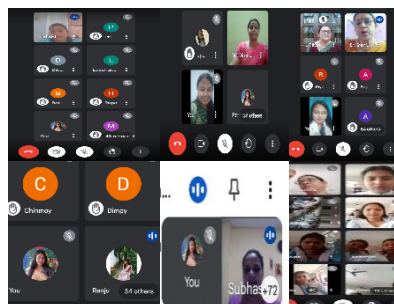

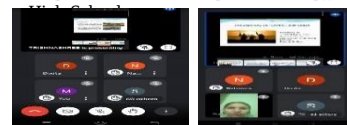

M.N.C.B.M Office Staff Beautify Campus with Self-Made Garden Project



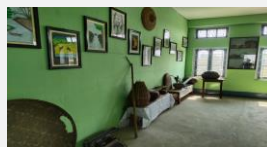
